Presentation (is the information clearly communicated?) <i>Look at language, layout, structure, etc...</i>			
Relevance (does the information match the needs of the searcher?) <i>Look at the introduction or overview – what is it mainly about?</i>			
Objectivity (Is the author's position of interest made clear?) <i>Look for an introduction or overview – do the writers state their position on the issue? Is the language emotive? Are there hidden, vested interests?</i>			
Method (research reports only) (Is it clear how the data was collected?) <i>Were the methods appropriate? Do you trust it?</i>			
Provenance (Is it clear where the information has come from?) <i>Can you identify the authors or organisations? How was it published?</i>			
Timeliness (Is it clear when the information was Produced?) <i>Does the date of the information meet your requirements? Is it obsolete?</i>
